



Set aside these five evenings for a very special experience:

July 9 Why Doesn't It Rhyme?

A revealing discussion of the characteristics, techniques, and subjects of contemporary poetry, led by Professor Thomas Travisano.

July 16 Poetry and Politics

Noted New York City Jurist, the Honorable Bruce Wright, will discuss blacklisting and artistic freedom. Judge Wright, an accomplished poet and author of *Black Robes, White Justice*, will also read a selection of his own poetry.

July 23 The Art of the Translator

Dr. Aaron Kramer, who has translated a number of books by German and Yidish writers, will discuss the difficulties of translating while retaining rhyme and meter. Dr. Kramer, author of many books of poetry and literary criticism, will then read from his new book of poetry, *Indigo and Other Poems*.

July 30 Anti-Poetry Poetics

Two poets (William Carlos Williams and Francis Ponge) revolutionized modern poetry. Dr. William Fahey will discuss how these poets rejected traditional poetic forms and transformed modern poetry, and will conclude with a reading from his own poetry.

August 6 Poetry in Action


