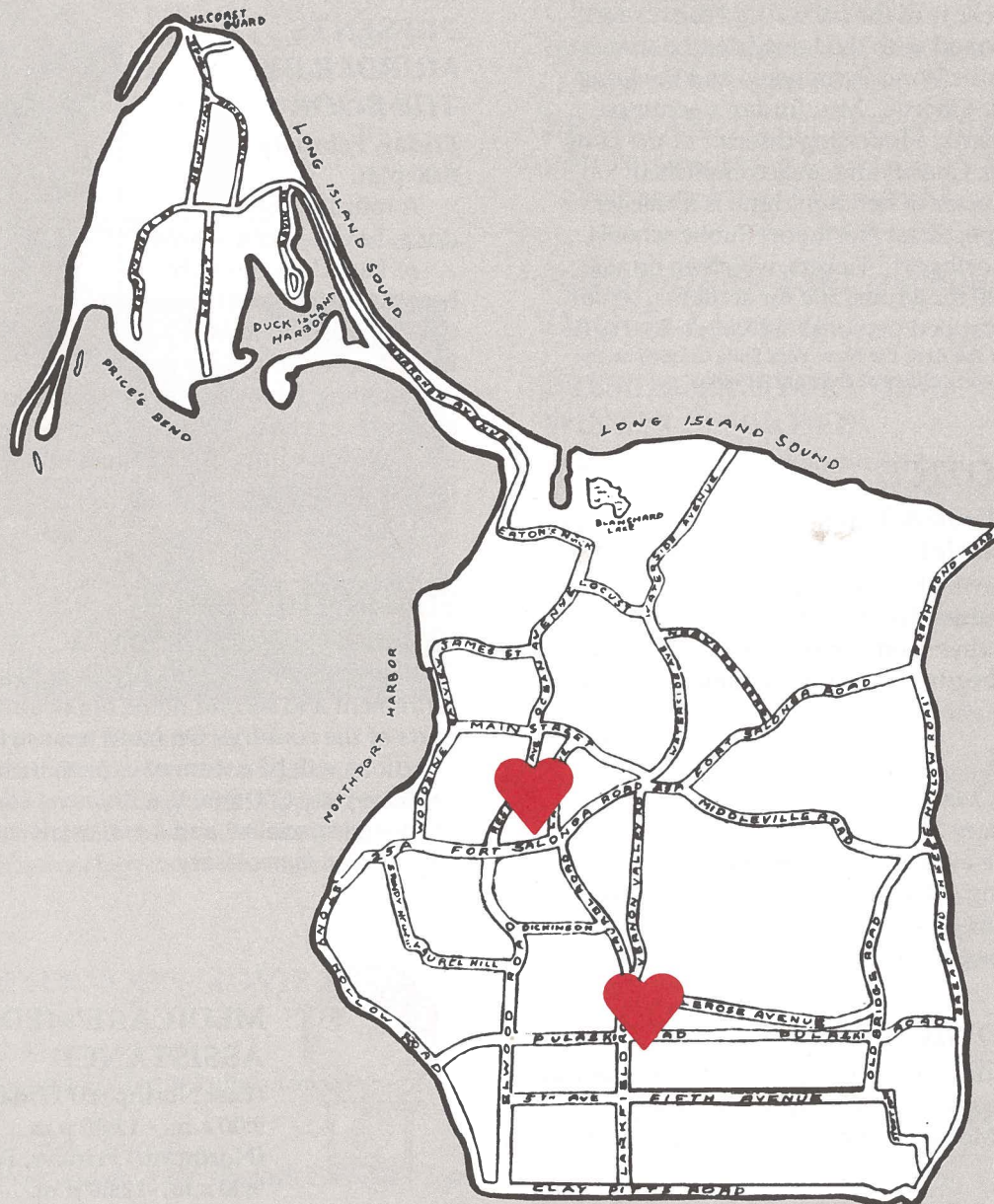

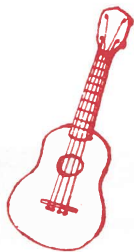

Osborn (verbal) and Joel Roth (math), have many years of teaching experience at the secondary school level, and have successfully tutored scores of students in preparations for the S.A.T.'s. In addition, both Mr. Osborn and Mr. Roth have conducted after school S.A.T. preparation classes at local high schools. Registration, which is limited, begins Feb. 12 at the Northport Library.

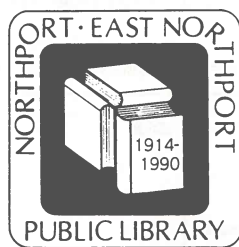
