Monday April 2, 1990

9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Voting will be for two purposes: to vote on the library budget for 1990/91 and to elect one trustee (5 year term).

Vote will take place at the Northport Public Library, 151 Laurel Ave., Northport.

YOU MAY VOTE in the library election if:

- 1. You are at least 18 years of age.
- 2. You are a citizen of the United States.
- 3. You have been a resident of the Northport-East Northport School District for at least 30 days.
- 4. You are registered to vote. (You are registered if you have voted within the last two years, in a general, school or library election.)

NOTE: Additional parking is available across the street in the Northport Junior High School parking lot.

Handicapped voters please use library side ramp.

The increase in the library tax rate will be 32¢ per \$100 of assessed valuation, or \$1.07 per month more than last year. This means that using \$4,000 as an average assessed valuation, library services will cost each family \$11.27 per month or \$135 per year.




