




This is my library: East Northport Public Library

I can look for books.




I can look for movies.

I can use the computer to play a game, look up information, or work on homework.




I might go to a library program in this room.

I can use the bathroom near the Children's Room.




If my grown-up lets me, we can go upstairs to get a snack or a drink at the café.
