I can look for books.



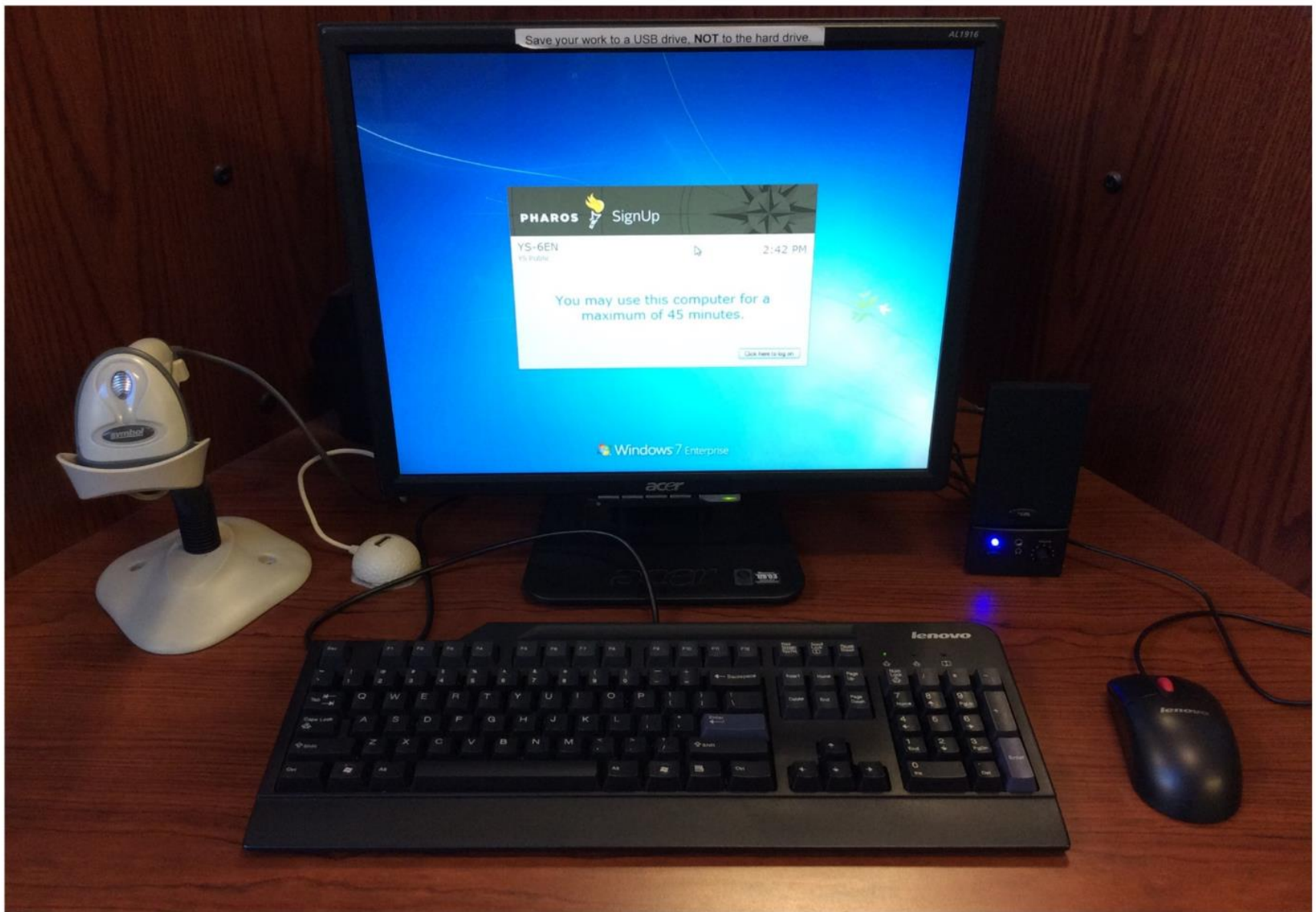
I can look for movies.

I might go to a library program in this room.



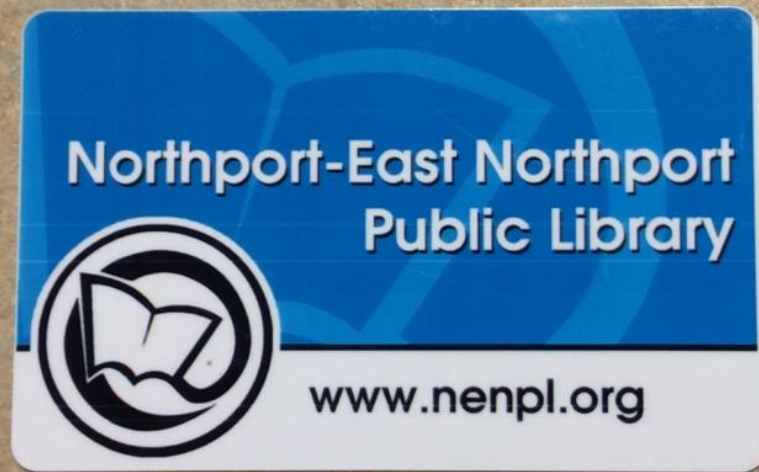
I might go to a program in this room too.
