Who Can Vote

- Anyone who is
 - at least 18 years of age;
 - a citizen of the United States;
 - a resident of the Northport-East Northport School District for at least 30 days;
 - registered to vote.

If you have not voted within four years in a general, school, or library election, re-registration is required.

Registration may be made in person prior to April 14 at the following location: the offices of the School District Clerk, 158 Laurel Avenue, Northport, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. any day that school is in session.

You may register prior to April 9 at the Suffolk County Board of Elections, Yaphank Ave., Yaphank, Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

You may register by mail using application forms available in both Library buildings. Applications must be received at the Suffolk County Board of Elections no later than April 9, 2004.

Absentee Applications — Applications for absentee ballots are available in both Library buildings.

 Two boys—one Catholic and one Jewish—try to figure out how they can guarantee they will go to heaven. Rated PG. 93 min.

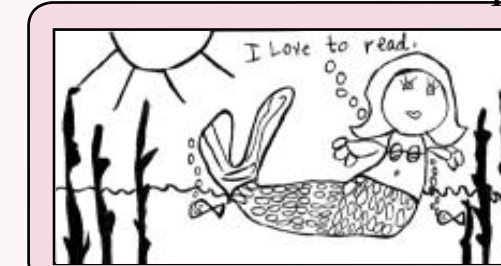

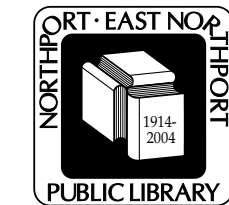


Stop by the Library and pick up March's bookmark by Alexandra DeMarfio. A reading list, compiled by our Children's Librarians, is on the back.

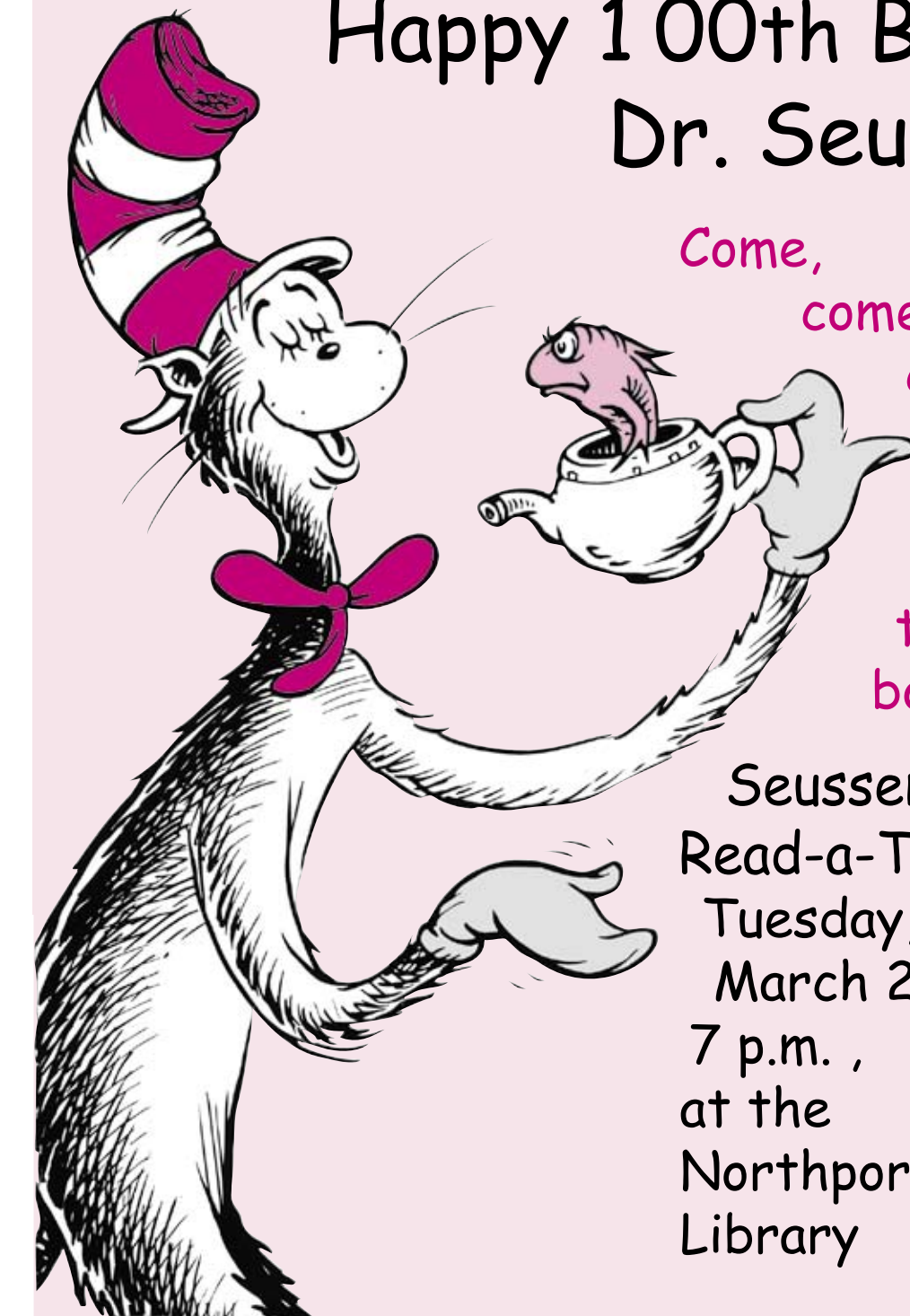
