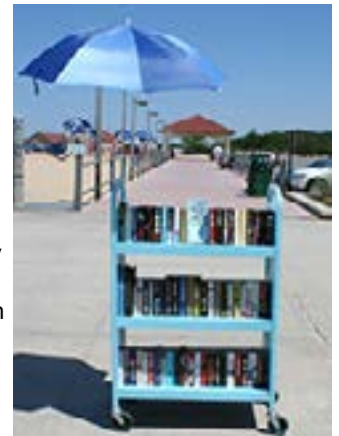
Marine Life Discovery Tank

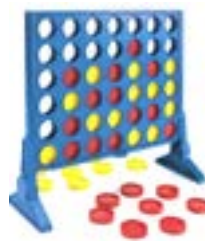


Beach Bag Books are back!
